Week 6 Swimming

3rd-7th March 2025

As our swimming week fast approaches, it is time for some handy tips on getting ready for Week 6. Swimming is an important part of the Health and Physical Education curriculum that helps students develop a range of knowledge, skills, understanding and attitudes about:

- Water confidence
- Survival in the water
- Swimming techniques
- Rescue of others
- Water safety

What to Pack

- Students can wear bathers under their uniform.
- Please pack a towel, a plastic bag for wet items, a change of underwear and uniform
- Any medication that is held at school will be taken to the pool by the classroom teacher.

Helpful Hints

- Clearly label all items, including swimwear, clothing, goggles, and towels.
- Hooded towels are a great idea as they allow students to be hands-free while dressing and drying, and they also provide a bit of extra privacy while changing.
- Before swimming lessons, practice getting into and out of swimming clothes and school uniforms with your child. Make it a game and set a timer to make it fun.
- Pack a spare bag for all their wet clothes after swimming.
- Teaching your child to dress and undress independently before swimming is a great idea.
- Goggles are important to protect children's eyes from chlorine.

Preschool & School Fees

School Card scheme (assistance for low-income families)

This is a valuable opportunity for families and teachers to build strong connections between school and home and gain insight into how their children have settled into the new school year. Building these strong and open lines of communication early in the year will ensure that we set all our learners up for success as the year progresses.



<u>NAPLAN</u>

In Weeks 7 and 8 of this term, our Year 3 and 5 students will participate in NAPLAN. NAPLAN is a national assessment that tests students' ability in three domains of literacy (reading, writing and language conventions) and in numeracy. These results are an important measure of our education system because they tell us how well we are equipping young Australians with critical literacy and numeracy skills.

- <u>For teachers</u>, NAPLAN gives access to student results for each question, which they can use to develop appropriate intervention strategies to improve outcomes.
- <u>For parents</u>, NAPLAN provides information on how their child is performing against national standards, not just against other children in a class.
- <u>For students</u>, NAPLAN provides an opportunity for them to demonstrate what they have learned.

It's a time to embrace inclusiveness, show respect, and foster a sense of belonging for everyone. 
