Preschool Belonging Tree

Experiencing **belonging** – knowing where you are and with whom you belong – is an integral part of human existence. It is important for children to understand that they have the right to belong to many different places. When they arrive at preschool they start to experience belonging to the Wandana preschool community. To help shape children's sense of who they are we have been working on growing our belonging tree. When our tree is complete it will be made up of:

- individual photos of each of the 40 children so that they can see themselves as part of a group
- educator's family photos to help build stronger connections and trusting relationships
- photos of the children's own families to keep the connection between preschool and home.



Room 12

This week's focus in Room 12 has been on **kindness**. Being kind to others as well as to ourselves helps us to feel better and create a safe and happy environment at our school.

The students took part in our Kindness Bingo Challenge. Their task was to fulfil little acts of kindness for others, our environment and themselves.

We also wrote a special kindness note to someone in our class and shared these as a way to promote positivity in our classroom and yard.

After completing this activity the students realised that it only takes a small act of kindness to make someone else and ourselves feel just that little bit better.
