Dear preschool families and caregivers,

Welcome back we hope you have all had a lovely break from preschool and that you found lots of interesting things to do together during the holidays. We have a busy and exciting term ahead of us so we hope you are all rested and ready.

We will begin by focusing on our garden and preparing it for some winter planting. If you have a green thumb and some time to spare we'd love to have your help to maintain the garden. If you have any seeds or seedlings at home to donate we'd really appreciate them.

We are excited to be planning our first excursion for the year. We will be attending the Botanical Gardens for the 'Little Sprouts Program,' It allows children to explore the wonders of a kitchen garden environment through a range of fun engaging learning opportunities. It is guided by a qualified kitchen garden educator, the program is hands on and aligned to the Early Years Framework.

As the term progresses our focus will shift to Aboriginal culture tying in with national sorry day, reconciliation week and NAIDOC week, we will have many opportunities to learn about Aboriginal people and their traditions.

On our first Funky Friday for term 2 we will be holding a special pampering afternoon in honour of the important and special women in our lives. This will be in week 2 on Friday 10th of May. We can't tell you too much about the afternoon or it wont be a surprise!! Be sure to look out for a special invitation to this event.

In week 4 we will be offering all of our families the opportunity to have a formal parent teacher interview with one of our teachers.
